The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-law Nos. 4536 and 4541, being by-laws to amend Zoning By-law No. 4404.

By-law No. 4536 amends the zoning of a portion of Headlease No. 18053 from "NP" – Nature Preservation to "PR" – Parks and Recreation. This amendment facilitates the development of a floatplane marina on the Kam Lake shoreline adjacent to the Curry Drive public boat launch.
