

CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE

BY-LAW NO. 3751

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, in the Northwest Territories to proclaim, a half day civic holiday on the Friday of every Caribou Carnival week.

PURSUANT TO Section 129(b) of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c. C-8.

WHEREAS it has been the custom to encourage the citizens of Yellowknife to enjoy and participate in the festivities of 'Caribou Carnival' and the Canadian Championship Dog Derby, on the Friday of every Caribou Carnival Week.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in the Northwest Territories, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

- 1. THAT the period from 12:00 Noon until 5:00 p.m. (Mountain Time) on the Friday of Caribou Carnival week each year is hereby declared to be a civic holiday.

REPEAL

- 2. THAT By-law No. 3533 is hereby repealed.

EFFECT

- 3. THAT this By-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 58 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.
