Sealed tenders marked "City of Yellowknife, Pumphouse No. 3 Fire Pump Replacement Project #04-015" will be received at City Hall, City of Yellowknife, NT **until 1:30:00 p.m.** local time on **Friday, July 23, 2004** (this has been extended from the original July 8, 2004 deadline) at which time the Tenders will be opened in public.

Deposits will be refunded if drawings and specifications are returned to point of origin complete, undamaged, unmarked and reusable within thirty (30) days of the Tender closing date.

Contract Documents may be examined at the offices of Ferguson Simek Clark in Yellowknife; at Yellowknife City Hall; at the NWT Construction Association office in Yellowknife; and at the Edmonton Construction Association office.

Each Tender must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of Ten Percent (10%) of the Tender amount plus a Consent of Surety, or a certified cheque in the amount of (10%) of the Tender amount.

The successful Tenderer will be required to provide a Performance Bond in the amount of Twenty Percent (20%) of the contract price, and a Labour and Material Payment Bond in the amount of Twenty Percent (20%) of the contract price, or a Security Deposit in the amount of Ten Percent (10%) of the contract price.
