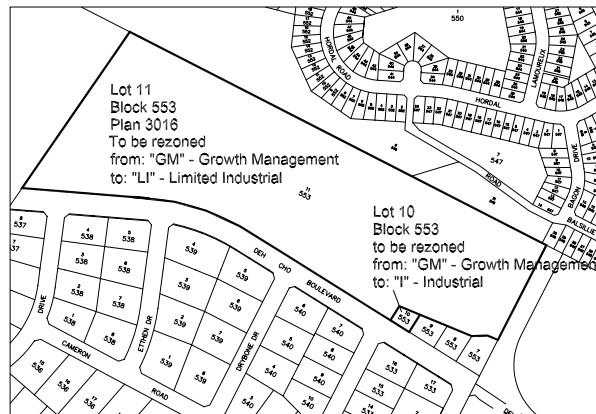
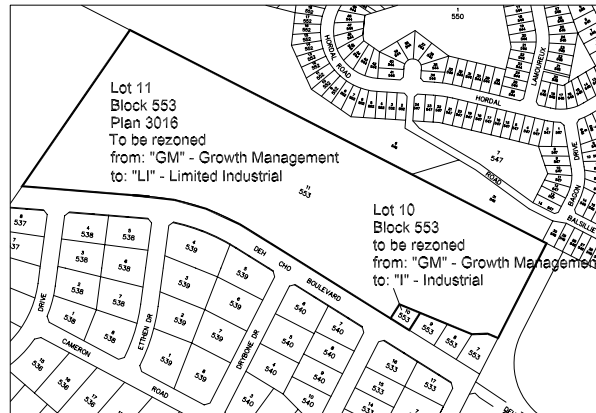

### PUBLIC HEARING

#### By-law Nos. 4286 & 4287

The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-law Nos. 4286 and 4287, by-laws amending General Plan (1996) By-law No. 3898, as amended, and Zoning By-law No. 4024, as amended. The intent of By-law Nos. 4286 and 4287 is to create a new "LI" - Light Industrial zoning designation for the industrial subdivision being developed by the City of Yellowknife on Lot 11, Block 553. The purpose of the new "LI" zoning designation is to provide an area for limited industrial and commercial land uses intended to minimize impacts on established land uses in the area.

**CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS**

**7<sup>th</sup> Annual Heritage Award**

Nominations are now open for the 7th Annual City of Yellowknife Heritage Award for any individual or organization who has made or continues to make significant contributions to the promotion and/or preservation of heritage resources in Yellowknife. Consideration will be given to nominees who have demonstrated a level of commitment, energy, quality and originality over a long period, for a one-time activity or for a series of events.

One award may be given each year. Nominations can be made by an individual or group. Nominations must be signed by at least three individuals who are unrelated to the nominee. Nominations can be sent by mail, fax, e-mail or delivery, and must be submitted no later than December 15, 2003. Supporting material may accompany the nomination.

**Nominations must include:**

- Name, mailing address and telephone number of nominee;
- Name, signature, mailing address and telephone number of each nominator;
- Description of the nominee's contributions to the promotion and/or preservation of heritage resources in Yellowknife.

**Process:**

Nominations will be reviewed by the City of Yellowknife Heritage Committee. The Committee will make recommendations to City Council for formal resolution/citation. The recipient of the Yellowknife Heritage Award will be announced in February 2004.
