Downtown Commercial Facade Improvement Program

The City of Yellowknife has approved funding to provide assistance to improve, renovate or rehabilitate the facades of commercial buildings in the downtown core.

The City will grant 50% of eligible improvement costs, to a maximum of \$10,000 per application, to undertake a range of building facade improvements. Property owners may apply to the Department of Public Safety and Development. Applications will be reviewed for approval by City Council.
