By-law Enforcement Review Committee

While City Council welcomes applications from all interested persons, those with a background and/or training in dispute resolution, law enforcement or who are Members of the Law Society of the Northwest Territories are particularly encouraged to apply.

Did You Know...?

The City would like to inform residents that snow accumulation so far this year is 33% above normal – that's one third more than average. The City is working hard to perform all necessary snow removal from Yellowknife streets, and will reach your road soon.
