SMOKING BY-LAW

Effective October 1, 2003

On October 1, 2003 the final phase of the Smoking By-law came into effect in the City of Yellowknife. The by-law will prohibit smoking in all public places.

In December 2002, City Council accelerated the implementation of a 100% ban on smoking in restaurants, licensed dining rooms, clubs, private recreational facilities and canteens from January 1, 2005 to April 2003. In May of 2003, City Council requested a further amendment to the by-law to include all public places, including bars and cocktail lounges, to establish a level playing field for businesses within the community.
