



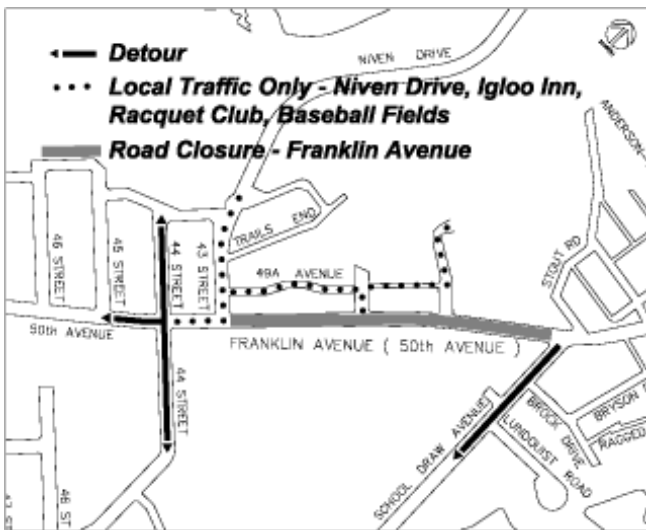

BOIL WATER ADVISORY

Status of Drinking Water

The City of Yellowknife and the Stanton Territorial Health Authority are monitoring the water and have observed that turbidity values for our water are dropping (becoming less discoloured); however, the levels are still above our historic values. We believe that if the current trend continues, the *Boil Water Advisory* may be lifted by the end of next week (ie. Friday, June 18, 2004). The reason for the high turbidity values is the erosion of an area along the bank of the Yellowknife River. Before the boil water advisory can be lifted, the City will flush the water mains. This may result in sediment being disturbed, which in turn may result in discolored water for a short period of time.

The City and Stanton Territorial Health Authority appreciate your patience as we work to providing residents with safe drinking water.
