



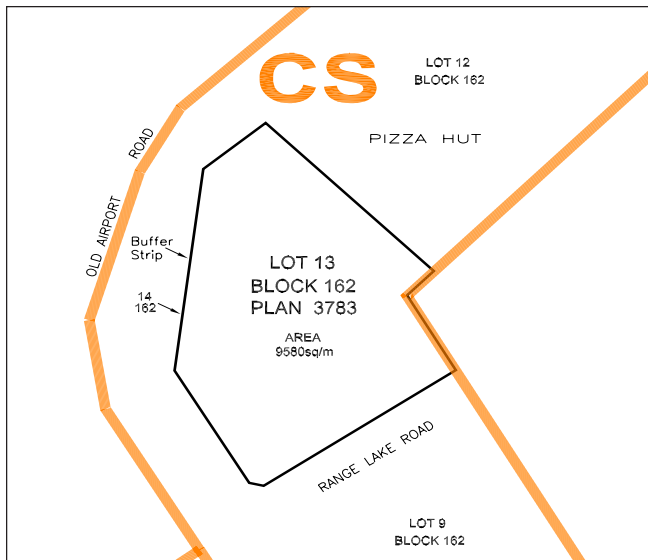

Proxy Voting

If you know that you will be unable to vote either at the Advance Poll or on Election Day, you may assign an eligible proxy voter to vote on your behalf at your polling station. It is recommended that you select a proxy voter who would otherwise vote at the same station as you. You must apply to the Returning Officer for a proxy form prior to Election Day.

Eligibility Criteria

You are eligible to vote if you:

- are a Canadian citizen;
- are 18 years of age on or before polling day; and
- have resided in the City of Yellowknife for a period of at least 12 consecutive months immediately preceding polling day.
