Notice to Ratepayers

The City of Yellowknife has traditionally borrowed for its road rehabilitation and paving program. On October 20, 2003 the ratepayers of Yellowknife will be asked whether they approve of the City borrowing, on the surety of debentures, the sum of \$1,930,000 for the purposes of financing the 2004 Road Rehabilitation and Paving Program. PUBLIC HEARINGS (2)

By-law No. 4282

The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-law No. 4282, a by-law amending Zoning By-law No. 4024, as amended. The intent of By-law No. 4282 is to specifically define "kennels" as a land use under the Zoning By-law, and to list "kennels" as a Conditionally Permitted Use in the "I" - Industrial and "GM" - Growth Management zones. As a Conditionally Permitted Use, a "kennel" must be approved by City Council.
