One award may be given each year. Nominations can be made by an individual or group. Nominations must be signed by at least three individuals who are unrelated to the nominee. Nominations can be sent by mail, fax, e-mail or delivery, and must be submitted no later than **Wednesday, December 15, 2004**. Supporting material may accompany the nomination.

Nominations must include:
