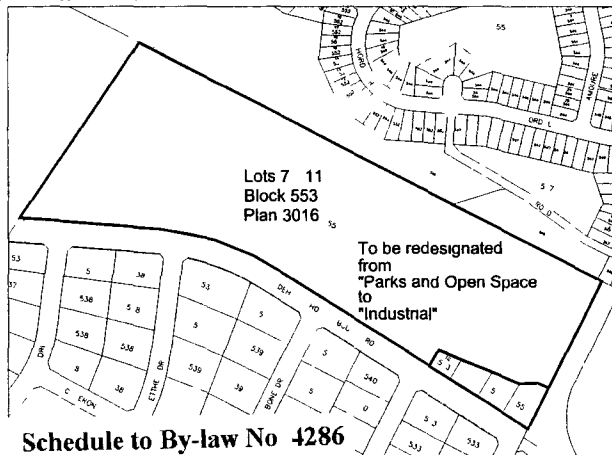
#### Dog Registration

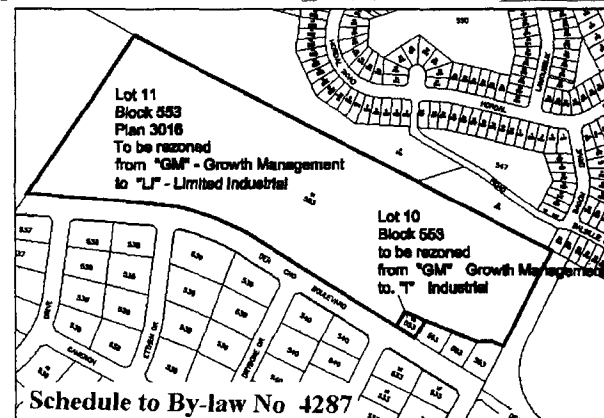
### PUBLIC HEARING

#### By-law Nos. 4286 & 4287

The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-laws No 4286 and 4287, being by-laws amending General Plan (1996) By-law No 3898 and Zoning By-law No 4024 respectively. The intent of By-law No 4286 is to amend the General Plan (1996) in accordance with Council's direction to create a new industrial subdivision on Lot 11, Block 553. The intent of By-law No 4287 is to create a new "LI" - Light Industrial zoning designation for Lot 11, Block 553 that will provide an area for limited industrial and commercial land uses intended to minimize impacts on established land uses in the area.

#### Municipal Enforcement Officer
