City of Yellowknife General Plan Progress, July 2003

This summer, the City of Yellowknife began the 2003 General Plan review. The team comprised of Terriplan Consultants and Dillon Consulting is currently undertaking a demographic analysis of the City and how issues such as population, birth rate and migration will affect the General Plan. The team is likewise reviewing important background information such as the City's infrastructure (roads, water and sewer servicing), the airport, land leases and other constraints to development. The team is also conducting interviews with some of the City's major stakeholders. These interviews are intended to gather information and identify issues regarding the planning process and the General Plan. The interviews will continue through the summer in preparation for the public forum in the fall.

The public forum will provide an opportunity for residents of Yellowknife to express their views regarding the proposed General Plan. Please watch for forum dates and times in future advertising.

The team is also looking to construct a public information kiosk. This kiosk will contain information regarding the progress of the general plan and will be updated periodically until the plan is finished. The public will be advised of the location of the kiosk when it is established.
