Water & Sewer

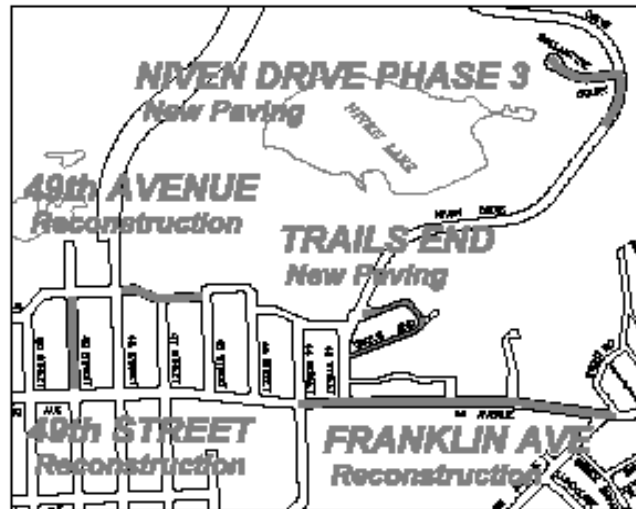
The City of Yellowknife wishes to inform you that initial construction work on the 2004 Water and Sewer capital projects has commenced.

Contract B consists of water and sewer work on **Rycon Drive** and Block 38 (the Polar Bowl Alley).

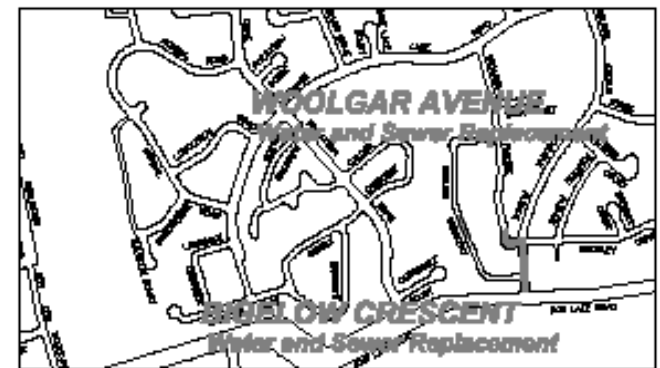
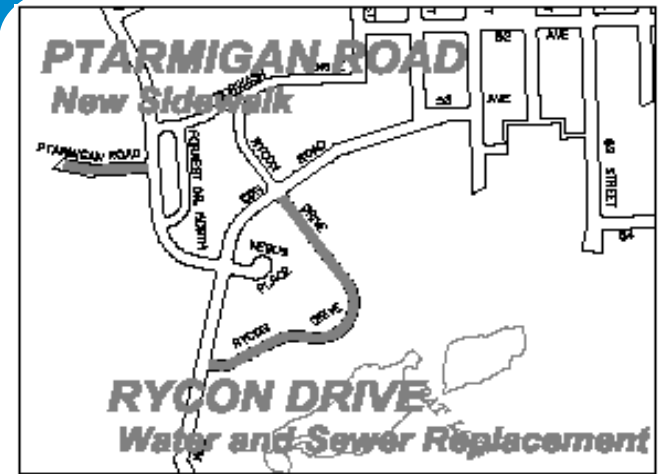
Paving
