Sealed tenders marked "City of Yellowknife, 2005 Water and Sewer Upgrade Contract 'B'" will be received at City Hall, City of Yellowknife, NT until 1:30:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, April 14, 2005, at which time the Tenders will be opened in public.

Tender documents may be obtained at the office of the Owner at City Hall, Yellowknife, NT, and at the office of the Engineer at Earth Tech (Canada) Inc., 17203 – 103 Avenue, Edmonton, AB.

One set of the Contract Documents will be available for each Tenderer. **RECYCLING****New Cardboard Bins**

You can now recycle your corrugated cardboard at the City of Yellowknife recycling depots as well as at the Solid Waste Facility. It is estimated that 40% of paper products (which includes cardboard) end up in the landfill. To reduce contamination and increase the amount each bin can contain, the openings are 8" x 56". Therefore, you may have to flatten larger cardboard boxes for them to fit inside the bin. The City will then bale the cardboard for transportation down south, where the cardboard will be recycled into other products.

**SNOW REMOVAL SCHEDULE****Week of April 4 to 8, 2005**

The snow removal season runs from the beginning of January to the end of March and is dependent on the weather. Residents are informed of snow being removed from City streets by radio ads and signs that are placed the day before removal. Snow removal begins at 1:00 a.m. and takes place during the early morning to avoid conflicts with motorists, pedestrians and children at play. The schedule for the week of April 4 to 8, 2005 is:

**FUNDING OPPORTUNITY****Downtown Commercial Facade Improvement Program**

The City of Yellowknife has 2005 funding available to provide assistance to improve, renovate or rehabilitate the exterior facades of commercial buildings in the downtown core area. The City will grant 50% of eligible improvement costs to a maximum of \$15,000 to undertake a range of building facade improvements.
