The City of Yellowknife will be opening the Christmas season with its annual Santa Claus Parade. The theme for this year's event is "A Fairy Tale Christmas."

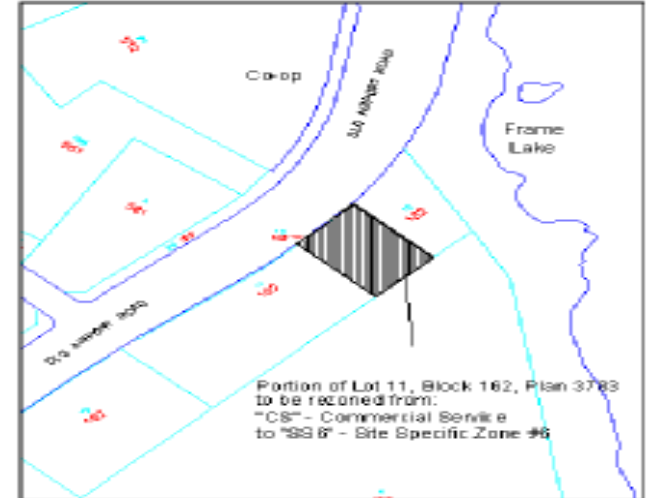
