Free Swim

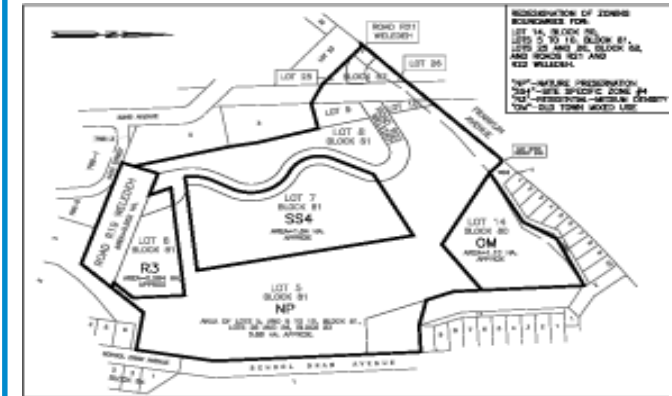

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

By-law No. 4370

The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-law No. 4370, a by-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 4024. The purpose of By-law No. 4370 is to redesignate zoning boundaries for the Twin Pine Hill area to reflect legally surveyed lot boundaries as outlined in Land Titles Office Plan No. 3950. The redesignated zoning boundaries are outlined below and are in keeping with the intent and total area calculations outlined pursuant to By-law No. 4216. By-law No. 4216 was adopted by City Council in March 2003 and created zoning designations at Twin Pine Hill in support of a proposal to develop a hotel.



The Council of the City of Yellowknife will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at **seven o'clock in the evening (7:00 P.M.) on Monday, July 25, 2005** in the City Hall Council Chamber to hear any representations to By-law No. 4370.
