The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to Zoning By-law No. 4404. Zoning By-law No. 4404 is the result of a fundamental review of existing Zoning By-law No. 4024 undertaken by the Zoning By-law Review Committee. Zoning By-law No. 4404 is intended to replace the existing Zoning By-law. Zoning By-law No. 4024 was adopted by City Council in June 2000. Significant areas of change within Zoning By-law No. 4404 include: the purpose; definitions; development permit and subdivision approval process; landscaping requirements; enforcement provisions and conformity with General Plan 2004 By-law No. 4315.

The Council of the City of Yellowknife will hold a PUBLIC HEARING at seven o'clock in the evening (7:00 P.M.) on Monday, June 26, 2006 in the City Hall Council Chamber to hear any submissions to Zoning By-law No. 4404.

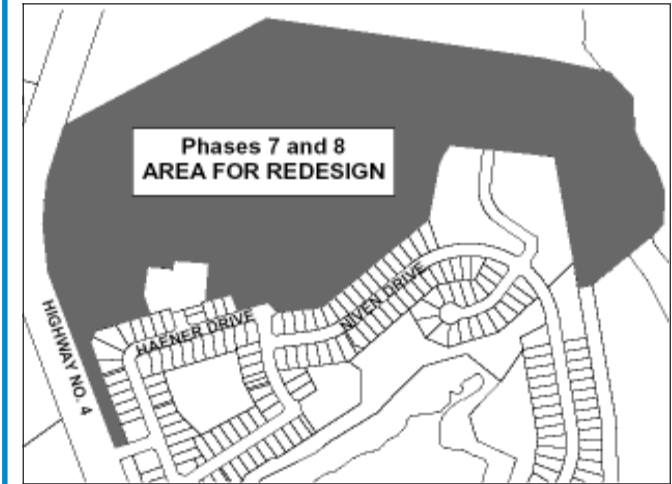
