Zoning By-law No. 4404 is the result of a fundamental review of existing Zoning By-law No. 4024 undertaken by the Zoning By-law Review Committee. Zoning By-law No. 4404 is intended to replace the existing Zoning By-law. Zoning By-law No. 4024 was adopted by City Council in June 2000. Significant areas of change within Zoning By-law No. 4404 include: the purpose; definitions; development permit and subdivision approval process; landscaping requirements; enforcement provisions and conformity with General Plan 2004 By-law No. 4315.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

2006 Water & Sewer and Paving

The City of Yellowknife wishes to inform residents that two major Water & Sewer projects will be completed this summer. The first consists of **Burwash Drive** from Forrest Drive. North to 56th Street and **Rycon Drive** between Con Road and Burwash Drive. The second project consists of water and sewer replacement on **Block 39** between 51st Ave. and 52nd Ave.

New paving will occur on **Bourque Drive** and on **Larocque Crescent**. Paving will also occur on **Gitzel Street** and along **School Draw Avenue** to cover areas where water and sewer reconstruction occurred in 2005. Road reconstruction is scheduled to commence on **49th Street** between Franklin Avenue and 52nd Avenue, **51st Avenue** between 46th Street and 47th Street and it is anticipated that the new access road to the Niven Lake Subdivision will also be constructed this summer. The downtown lane paving program will also start up again this summer.

Local meetings are planned for certain areas. Residents will be notified by door cards and Capital Update. Project details will be explained at these meetings, and any resident concerns related to the work will be addressed. For more information, please call the City at 920-5653.
