City crews are working hard to make the streets of Yellowknife safe for its citizens; however, you are urged to use extra caution when driving or walking on Yellowknife roads and sidewalks.

We also wish to remind our commercial and other residents in the Central Business District to keep the sidewalk(s) around their properties clear of ice and snow, and otherwise safe for pedestrian traffic. Failure to do so may result in a fine or other enforcement action pursuant to *Highway Traffic By-law No. 4063*. Let's work together to keep our sidewalks safe!

ROAD CONDITIONS

The City of Yellowknife wishes to advise residents that due to the record amount of snow that has accumulated to-date, the City may have no choice but to push snow from roads to the curbs in order to keep roads open to traffic. If this method is used, this will create a snow ridge across residents' driveways and residents will have to shovel out their driveway entrances. City By-law No. 4063 states that if residents are shoveling out their driveways, they must **not** put snow back onto the street as this can be a traffic hazard.
