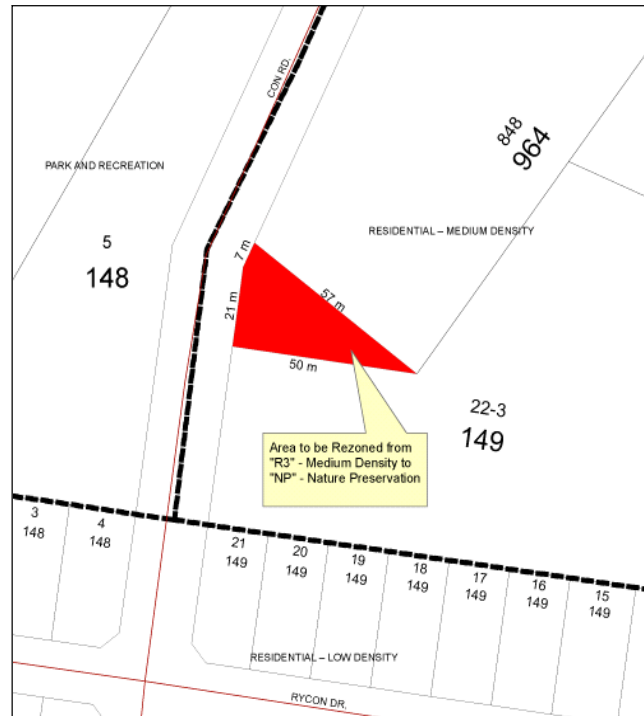
## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS (2)

### By-law No. 4427

The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-law No. 4427, a by-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 4024 by designating the Yellowknife Post Office, located on Lots 11 and 12, Block 23, Plan 65 (4902 Franklin Avenue) as a heritage site. The proposed amendment recognizes the historical significance of the Post Office building and accords the preservation offered by this designation under Zoning By-law No. 4024.
