FALL CLEAN UP

The 2006 Fall Clean Up is scheduled to take place during the week of September 18, 2006.

Amnesty Week - September 18 - 22, 2006 - Commercial and Residential. The City encourages everyone to take advantage of Amnesty Week at the Solid Waste Facility. The \$5 fee will be waived during this week for large items and grass clippings. Hazardous waste will not apply to amnesty week. Tipping fees and the 3 bag limit for curb-side pick up still apply. Large Item Pick Up - September 18 - 22, 2006. This service is for residents who do not have the means to transport bulky waste to the Solid Waste Facility. Typical items for pick up include: furniture, tv's, computers, bicycles, carpet, BBQ's (no propane tanks), and lawn furniture. Items that will **not** be picked up include hazardous waste, and recyclable materials.
