OPEN BURNING BAN ISSUED

Effective immediately, an open burning ban has been placed into effect for the City of Yellowknife. The City of Yellowknife, in coordination with the GNWT Department of Environment and Natural Resources, uses Fire Weather Indices to evaluate fire weather conditions. The City has been in a "High" to "Extreme" category for the past 2 weeks (14 days), as such an immediate mandatory open burning ban has been placed into effect for the City of Yellowknife. The ban will include the use of approved fire pits within the City.

Fire Pit and Burning Permit Changes

Burning Permits

- Class 1 permits are for the burning of cleared trees and brush from development areas. (We are discontinuing residential class 1 permits, and cleared brush and trees is required to go to landfill).
- Class 2 permits are for the burning of grass only.
- Class 3 is for recreational burning (cooking and warmth) in fire department rented fire pits (\$50.00) cheque or cash only. All money is returned on return of burn barrel.

Fire Pits

Residential approved fire pit requirements are available from YKFD. No burning permit is required for approved fire pits. Residents may rent a fire pit or have an approved fire pit for burning (no exceptions).
