Express Transit Routes

Beginning September 4, 2007, the City of Yellowknife will be running two express transit routes during weekday peak times. The Borden/Northlands route begins at 7:50 a.m., picks up at the designated express stops on Borden, Magrum and Norseman and drops off downtown at the Northwest Tower, A&W and the high schools. The Frame Lake South route begins at 7:55 a.m., picks up at the designated express stops on Finlayson, Woolgar and Byrne Road and drops off downtown at the Northwest Tower, A&W and the high schools. The afternoon routes begin at the high schools at 3:45 p.m. and drop off in the Borden/Northlands or Frame Lake South areas.

FALL CLEAN UP WEEK

Large Items Pick-Up September 17 to 20, 2007

The 2007 Fall Clean Up is scheduled to take place the week of **September 17 to 20, 2007** (weather permitting). During this week only, residents can have their large items collected by the City **free of charge**.

Residents wishing to have items picked up must fill out a form which can be picked up from City Hall or the Gatehouse at the Landfill, on the City's website, filled in online and sent to amorley@yellowknife.ca **no later than 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Monday, September 17, 2007. The City can not accept any requests made after this deadline.**

The schedule is as follows: Monday: Frame Lake South, Range Lake North, Northland Trailer Park areas; Tuesday: Frame Lake South, Range Lake North, Northland Trailer Park areas; Wednesday: Central Business District, School Draw, Forrest Drive, Taylor Road, Matonabee Street, Rycon Drive & Con Road areas; and Thursday: Old Town, Latham Island and Niven Lake areas.

Please note the following restrictions:

NO CATEGORY I – TIPPING FEE ITEMS with applicable tipping fees will **NOT** be picked up, such as: fridges, stoves, microwaves, dishwashers, cars, tires and residential construction waste.

NO CATEGORY II – HAZARDOUS WASTE ITEMS will **NOT** be picked up, such as: batteries, paints, solvents, oils, chemicals, oil tanks, animal waste, small engines/motors, propane tanks & motor bikes.

NO CATEGORY III – RECYCLABLE ITEMS will **NOT** be picked up, such as: cardboard, glass, newspaper and grass clippings, yard waste and brush.
