Garbage Collection

Residential garbage that would get picked up regularly on Tuesday, December 25 and Tuesday, January 1 will instead get picked up on Monday, December 24 and Monday, December 30. The landfill will be closed on December 25, 26 and January 1.

Water Delivery and Sewer Pumpout

There will be no water deliveries or sewage pump out on Tuesday, December 25 or Tuesday, January 1. Residents who normally get pumped out on Tuesday will have their sewage pumped out on Monday, December 24 and on Monday, December 31, 2007. Residents who normally get water delivery on Monday, December 24 will instead be serviced on Sunday, December 23 and residents who normally get water delivery on Tuesday, December 25 will instead be serviced on Monday, December 24. Similarly, residents who normally get water delivery on Monday, December 31 will instead be serviced on Sunday, December 30 and residents who normally get water delivery on Tuesday, January 1 will instead be serviced on Monday, December 31. All services regularly scheduled for Wednesday, December 26 and Wednesday, January 2 will continue as normal.
