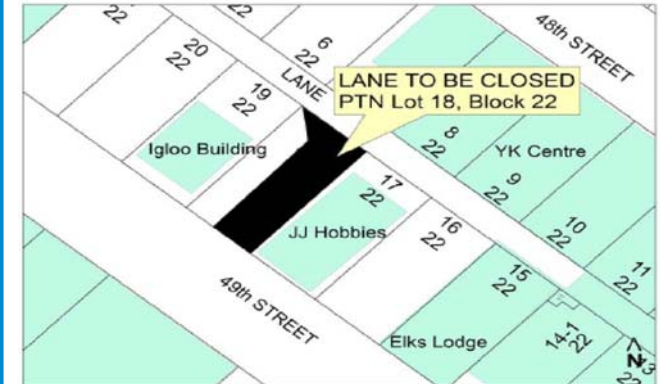

Notice of Intention to Close a Lane

Pursuant to Section 88 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, c.22, Notice is hereby given of the intention of the City of Yellowknife to pass a by-law to close a lane located on a portion Lot 18, Block 22, Plan 65 (adjacent to the former JJ Hobbies Building) and running from 49th Street to the main lane in Block 22, as shown on the sketch below. The purpose of the closures is to enable the sale of the subject lane for consolidation with adjacent properties for a redevelopment project.
