Network Support Specialist

Under the general direction of the Manager, the incumbent is responsible for providing support for the users of the City's information technology infrastructure. This includes supporting, maintaining and enhancing the operations of the City's computers, servers, networks, and related equipment and assisting all City staff in the ongoing use of this infrastructure.

The ideal candidate will possess a minimum of a two year technical diploma from a recognized post secondary institution, two years of related experience and a valid Class 5 driver's license. Current industry certification in network technologies relevant to the City's infrastructure is desirable.
