#### Sidewalks & Driveways

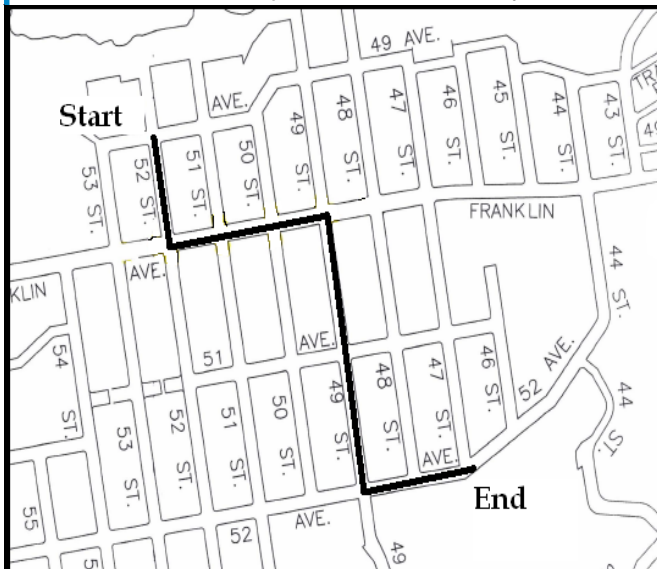
