The Downtown Enhancement Committee in conjunction with the City of Yellowknife's Planning and Lands Division invite Yellowknife residents to the 50th Street Streetscaping Public Consultation Sessions. Walking tours will be held on **Monday, April 28 and Tuesday, April 29, 2008 at 12:15 p.m. and 5:15 p.m.** beginning at the front foyer of City Hall. Residents are also invited to the design meeting at the Explorer Hotel on **Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at 7:00 p.m.**

The purpose of these events is to develop a streetscape vision for 50th Street from 49th Avenue to 52nd Avenue through an interactive public participation process. The process will allow for public input on design issues relating to traffic-calming, parking, pedestrianism, and aesthetics.

The walking tours will concentrate on generating streetscaping design ideas from a street-level perspective. The consultation meeting will include a presentation on urban design principles, a design charette for the subject area, and a discussion of community priorities for 50th Street. Concepts from the meeting and walking tours will be incorporated by a design consultant into a practical streetscape plan that improves the appearance, safety, and attractiveness of this street.
