3 Cell Salvaging

The City and the Solid Waste Management Advisory Committee will be hosting a public forum on **Wednesday, March 19, 2008, 7:00 p.m.**, at Northern United Place, to obtain public feedback. Administration will be suggesting the following measures for the three-cell salvaging system: Consists of three separate cells which will each be used to hold salvageable items; and an accompanying waste drop off area designed on a loop system.
