### Somba K'e Civic Plaza Construction

The City of Yellowknife wishes to advise the public that crews are preparing to commence work on the Phase 1 Development of the brand new Somba K'e Civic Plaza. As a result of this work, the City would like to make note of the following disruptions to some of its services:

#### Trail Redirection

The Frame Lake Trail will remain open; however, it will be diverted away from the waterfront. Please use caution when walking near the construction area.

#### Parking

Visitor Parking for City Hall will be temporarily relocated to the current Somba K'e parking lot, next to the old Gerry Murphy site. There will be a limited number of visitor parking spaces, which will be on a first come, first serve basis. Handicap parking will be available on 49 Avenue in the marked, designated spaces.

#### Bill Payment

During construction, City Hall will remain open for business and payments can continue to be made with the receptionist during City Hall hours. Online payments are also available. **Insulation Standards for Existing Buildings**

Contractors, Builders and Property Owners: If you are planning projects involving insulation for additions, renovations or upgrades to existing buildings, please be advised that the Minimum Insulation Value (Section 6.7) requirements in Building By-law No. 4469 has been deferred until January 1, 2010 pending a review of the Section 6.7 by a working group. The amending By-law No. 4486 became effective May 26, 2008.

In the interim, Contractors, Builders and Property Owners should continue to use the Insulation Standards established by the Building Inspection Division, Bulletin #4 dated February 1, 1996 for insulation for additions, renovations or upgrades to existing buildings.
