### PUBLIC MEETING

#### Landscaping, Trails and Environmental Inventory for the Engle Business District Phase 2 - 3 Development (West of Airport)

In keeping with the directives of both Smart Growth and the Yellowknife Municipal General Plan, the City of Yellowknife Planning Department is engaging in an Environmental Inventory and Assessment of the Engle Business District Concept Plan, as well as landscaping and transportation related plans. The concept plan targets future industrial and commercial development in the Engle Business District, including lands comprising the Fiddler's Lake Road Ecologically Sensitive Area.

The team working on the preparation of the development design plans include the City of Yellowknife, Hilderman Thomas Frank Cram (internal trail system and greenway) and Golder Associates Ltd. (environmental), as well as Avens Associates on behalf of the Department of Transportation.

The meeting will include three presentations. City and Department of Transportation representatives will present an overview of the project; Golder will present information currently being collected in an environmental inventory of the area and discuss the implications to the proposed development plan. HTFC and Avens Associates are currently preparing landscape design and trail options and will be presenting initial concepts for the industrial development and green spaces.

Feedback and comments will be solicited and collected regarding all aspects of the project discussed.

The meeting will be held on **Thursday, July 3, 2008** in the lower boardroom at City Hall from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. with the presentations beginning promptly at 7:15 p.m.

**Somba K'e Civic Plaza Construction**

The City of Yellowknife wishes to advise the public that crews are preparing to commence work on the Phase 1 Development of the brand new Somba K'e Civic Plaza. As a result of this work, the City would like to make note of the following disruptions to some of its services:

**Trail Redirection** – The Frame Lake Trail will remain open; however, it will be diverted away from the waterfront. Please use caution when walking near the construction area.

**Parking** – Visitor Parking for City Hall will be temporarily relocated to the current Somba K'e parking lot, next to the old Gerry Murphy site. There will be a limited number of visitor parking spaces, which will be on a first come, first serve basis. Handicap parking will be available on 49 Avenue in the marked, designated spaces.

**Bill Payment** – During construction, City Hall will remain open for business and payments can continue to be made with the receptionist during City Hall hours. Online payments are also available.
