Arctic Winter Games Transit Route

The City of Yellowknife will be implementing changes to the regular transit routes during the Arctic Winter Games. From March 10 through March 14, Routes 1 & 2 will remain on their regular schedules with Route 1 making an additional stop at the Multiplex. There will be an additional bus which will run from the Athletes Centre by City Hall, to Bristol Pit, the Golf Course and the Ski Club. This bus will run every hour from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. with the last pick up at the Athletes Centre at 7:00 p.m.

All transit will be free from March 10 through March 15.
