#### Manager, Public Works & Engineering

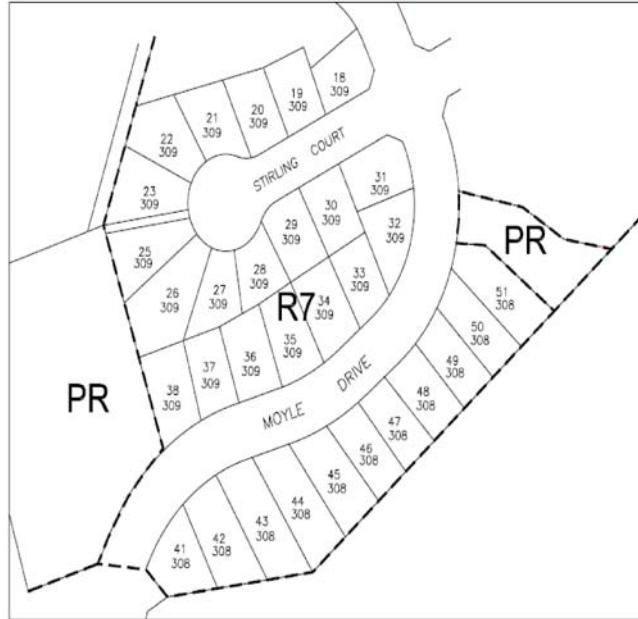
