City Hall Parking/49 Avenue

Visitor parking for City Hall has been relocated to the current Somba K'e park, next to the old Gerry Murphy site. 49 Avenue is currently under construction and is open to **local traffic only** which include conducting business at City Hall. Disabled parking spots and loading zones are still available along 49 Avenue until further notice.

Bill Payments

OPPORTUNITY FOR INPUT

At the regularly scheduled Municipal Services Committee meeting of September 2, 2008, a proposal from Northland Utilities was presented for the construction of a new substation adjacent to Olexin Park on 52nd Street. This substation is necessary to complete the upgrade of the electrical distribution system in Yellowknife from a system voltage of 5kV to 25kV. At the meeting, 3 location sites were proposed for consideration: (1) directly adjacent 52nd Street, (2) further south, directly west of the Olexin Park lot, and (3) north of the existing 5kV substation on 54th Street. Of these 3 options, City Administration has recommended Option #3. As part of the Development Permit Approval process, NUL will be required to notify adjacent property owners. FALL CLEAN UP

**Residential Large Items Pick-Up
September 15 - 18, 2008**

The 2008 Fall Clean Up is scheduled to take place the week of **September 15 - 18, 2008** (weather permitting). During this week only, residents can have their large items collected by the City **free of charge**.

Residents wishing to have items picked up must fill out a form which can be picked up from City Hall, or the Gatehouse at the Landfill and dropped off, mailed or faxed to City Hall at 669-3421. Forms are also available on the City's website, and can be filled in online and sent to tpilgrim@yellowknife.ca. **Deadline to receive forms is 3:00 p.m. on Friday, September 12, 2008. The City can not accept any requests made after this deadline.** NOTE: Kam Lake is zoned industrial and is not included in the Residential Large Item Pick-Up.

The schedule is as follows: **Monday:** Frame Lake South, Range Lake North, Northland Trailer Park areas; **Tuesday:** Frame Lake South, Range Lake North, Northland Trailer Park areas; **Wednesday:** Central Business District, School Draw, Forrest Drive, Taylor Road, Matonabee Street, Rycon Drive & Con Road areas; **and Thursday:** Old Town, Latham Island and Niven Lake areas.

Please note the following restrictions:

NO CATEGORY I – TIPPING FEE ITEMS with applicable tipping fees will **NOT** be picked up, such as: fridges, stoves, microwaves, dishwashers, cars, tires and residential construction waste.

NO CATEGORY II – HAZARDOUS WASTE ITEMS will **NOT** be picked up, such as: batteries, paints, solvents, oils, chemicals, oil tanks, animal waste, small engines/ motors, propane tanks & motor bikes.

NO CATEGORY III – RECYCLABLE ITEMS will **NOT** be picked up, such as: cardboard, glass, newspaper and grass clippings, yard waste and brush.

Amnesty Week

For residential drop off only, will take place from **September 15 – 21, 2008**. Amnesty Week will waive the \$5.00 fee at the Solid Waste Facility but other tipping fees and 3-bag limit for curbside collection still apply.
