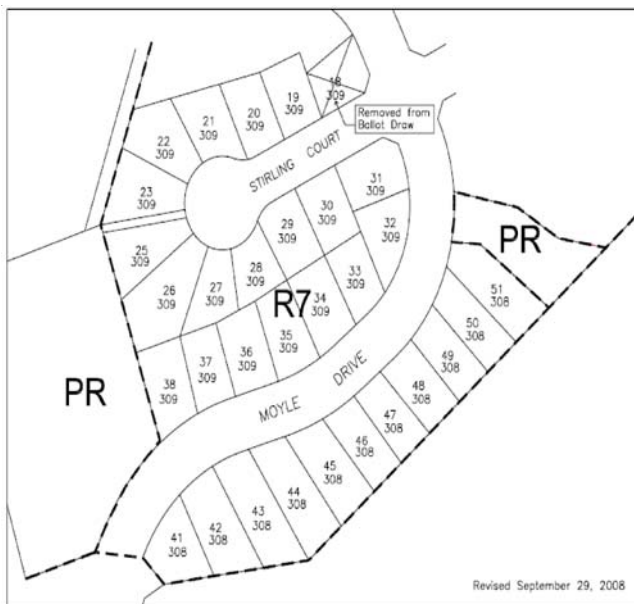

An estimated four thousand (4,000) m³ of crushed aggregate will be required. However, the City reserves the right to vary the quantities to meet snowfall conditions and budget constraints.

Traffic Survey

As previously reported, the City retained the services of iTRANS Consulting Inc. to prepare a detailed Transportation Improvement Study.

As part of the study, the City and iTRANS will conduct two public surveys. The first, a telephone survey, will be conducted over the next few weeks. City representatives will call several hundred City residents at random inquiring about, amongst other things, their driving habits, their driving destinations, and the number of times they travel in their cars each day. The second survey, a detailed roadside survey of motorists, will be conducted later. It will ask similar questions about the nature of vehicle travel in the region.

The City is asking residents to give a little bit of their time and accommodate the representatives' questions about their driving habits. The information the City expects to gain from the surveys will be invaluable in guiding future transportation planning as the City continues to grow and will allow the City of Yellowknife to continue to provide the highest level of service possible during your commute.
