2009 DOG REGISTRATION

2009 Dog Tags are now available!

Pick up your dog tag at the Municipal Enforcement Division in City Hall, Great Slave Animal Hospital or Borealis Dog Kennels. Licenses are valid through December 31, 2009. The cost is \$25.00 per dog or only \$7.00 if the dog has been sprayed or neutered. Simply bring in proof of rabies inoculation in the past 12 months and proof of spraying or neutering to one of the above locations. Without a license the fine for picking up your unlicensed dog is \$75.00 versus only \$40.00 for a licensed dog. Licensing your dog may be the only source of identifying your pet and making sure they get home to you.

DO YOU OWN A SNOWMOBILE?

You must register your snowmobile with the City of Yellowknife to drive within Yellowknife City limits. Snowmobile registrations for the 2007/2008 season expired on September 30, 2008, therefore you are reminded to renew your registration at City Hall. Remember to bring your previous registration and proof of insurance. If you are registering a snowmobile for the first time, you will need a bill of sale or proof of ownership. Please ride responsibly!
