FIRE SAFETY AND EDUCATION

Carbon Monoxide Safety

Carbon Monoxide ("CO") is a "silent killer". It is an invisible, odourless and poisonous gas produced when you use your fuel-burning appliance. Poor maintenance of appliances may cause a buildup of CO in your home.
Safety:

- Maintain your furnace and fireplace
- Install CO alarms (replace them every 5 years)
 - If battery operated, change the batteries annually
- Know the symptoms (nausea, headache, burning eyes, confusion & drowsiness). If they appear, open all the windows and get everyone outside.

Nominations

The City of Yellowknife hereby gives notice to the voters of Yellowknife that an election for Mayor (1) and Councillors (8), and for Trustees for Yellowknife Education District No. 1 (7) and Yellowknife Catholic Schools (7) is proposed to be held on Monday, October 19, 2009.

Nomination papers may be obtained as of Monday, August 31 at 8:00 a.m. from the Returning Officer at City Hall, and must be returned to the Returning Officer personally or to the office of the Returning Officer before 3:00 p.m. on Monday, September 14th.

Candidates must be nominated by 2 eligible voters.

Advance Poll

Residents who will be absent on Election Day may vote at the Advance Poll which will take place on Monday, October 5, 2009 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at City Hall in the lower boardroom.

Proxy Forms

For anyone unable to vote at the Advance Poll on October 5 or during Election Day on October 19, you may request a proxy voter application from the Returning Officer at City Hall. The deadline to apply is Friday, October 16 at 5:00 p.m. Please note that the Proxy Voter must be eligible to vote in the Election and must vote for you at your Polling Station.

School Board Elections

Pursuant to the Education Act of the NWT, residents may vote for either the Yellowknife Education District No. 1 School Board of Trustees or the Yellowknife Catholic School Board of Trustees, but not both. Be sure that your information on the Voters List is correct, you are not permitted to change your school support on Election Day. The last day to request a revision to the Voters List is October 9, 2009.
