EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

EOI #09-028 - Public Dock Area Former Giant Mine Townsite

The City of Yellowknife is inviting expressions of interest from non-profit organizations and commercial businesses for use of waterfront lands at the former Giant Mine townsite. The objective is to facilitate water-based recreational uses while enhancing public access to the waterfront.

Interested organizations and businesses must be based in Yellowknife and include in their submissions:

- A written statement indicating the proposed end-use, proposed parking and other improvements, and any conditions or restrictions that might impact public access to or use of the water fronting the existing public dock and boat launch.
- A site plan (to scale) delineating the area and dimensions desired and the location and size of proposed improvements.

The City reserves the right to enter into discussions with any one or more submitters, however, the City shall not be compelled to do so, nor shall it be compelled to facilitate any of the submissions received.

In the event that the City does decide to facilitate one or more submissions, or a variance(s), the proponent(s) would be required to enter into a sub-lease agreement with the City for the lands involved and to comply with the legislation and regulations of all applicable jurisdictions.

Submissions **MUST** be received at City Hall, 4807 - 52 Street, Yellowknife, NT, before **1:30 pm local time on Thursday, April 30, 2009.**

FIRE SAFETY AND EDUCATION

Candle Safety

"When you go out... blow out"

Open flame is one of the fastest ways of starting a house fire. Following these candle safety tips will help prevent this from happening in your home:

- Never leave burning candles unattended. Stay in the room where they are burning and extinguish them when you leave.
- Keep lit candles at least 12 inches away from flammable objects.
- Place candles away from windows or doorways or anywhere a draft could affect the flame.
- Use sturdy candle holders that won't tip or burn.
- Keep hair and clothing away from the flame.
- Avoid using candles during power outages. Use flashlights instead.
- Store candles, matches, and lighters high and out of children's sight and reach, preferably in a locked cabinet.
