SAFETY TIPS FOR MOTORISTS

Bikes, cars and other users can coexist safely and peacefully on city roads. Here are a few ways you can help make this happen:

- Look for bicyclists before turning and before opening doors.
- Do not overtake a bicyclist before making a right turn. Instead, slow down, merge, and then turn.
- Do not assume that a bicyclist will ride as far to the right as possible. Good cyclists ride about three feet from the edge of the road, which makes them more visible to motorists and gives them space to manoeuvre around road hazards.
- Allow bicyclists to enter your lane to make a left turn.
- Remember that bicycles are vehicles and are allowed to ride on the roads.
- Do not drive or park in bike lanes. You may, however, cross them when turning or exiting a legally assigned parking space.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

By-law No. 4527 & By-law No. 4528

The City of Yellowknife has given First Reading to By-law No. 4527, being a by-law to amend 2004 General Plan By-law No. 4315 and By-law No. 4528, being a by-law to amend Zoning By-law No. 4404.

1. The purpose of By-law No. 4527 is to amend 2004 General Plan By-law No. 4315 by removing references to Tin Can Hill as an area for immediate future residential development.

2. The purpose of By-law No. 4528 is to rezone a portion of Lot 1, Block 203, Plan 4019, otherwise known as "Tin Can Hill" from "GM" - Growth Management to "PR" - Parks and Recreation.

The proposed amendments will ensure the preservation of the Tin Can Hill area and prevent immediate future residential development. A defined quantum of open space would serve to allow continued planning of Tin Can Hill area within a framework that would more effectively guarantee citizens a well-defined recreation and preservation area.
