50th Street Reconstruction

The City of Yellowknife wishes to advise residents that beginning **June 26, 2009**, asphalt and concrete removals will begin on 50th Street between 49th Avenue and Franklin Avenue followed by reconstruction activities. Parking will not be permitted on this street during construction; however, pedestrian traffic will still be maintained. All pedestrians and motorists must obey all traffic signs in the area and should be aware of equipment and crews working nearby.

Asphalt Milling

The City of Yellowknife wishes to advise residents that beginning the week of **June 23, 2009**, asphalt milling will occur on Old Airport Road between Highway No. 3 and Cemetery Road, Finlayson Drive between Kam Lake Road and Range Lake Road, on 50th Street between 49th Avenue and Franklin Avenue and finally on Kam Lake Road at Deh Cho Boulevard. Lane alterations and reductions will occur as required and will be in place until work is complete. Motorcyclists should use extra caution when traveling on the milled surface. All motorists must obey all traffic signs.

Cabin Fire Safety

- Install a 2A10BC fire extinguisher; take it in for servicing annually.
- Keep a clean fire zone around your cabin; clean up fallen leaves and branches.
- Cut back any branches or brush that has grown too close to your fire pit.
- Don't use flower pots as ashtrays.

FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

Downtown Commercial and Residential Condominium Facade and Site Improvement Program

The City of Yellowknife has funding available in 2009 to provide assistance to improve, renovate or rehabilitate the facades of commercial buildings and residential condominiums in the downtown core area. The City will grant 50% of eligible improvement costs to a maximum of \$30,000 for a façade or combined façade and site improvement, and \$20,000 for a site improvement only, for commercial and residential condominium properties of eight (8) units or more in the downtown core area.
