## FIRE SAFETY AND EDUCATION

### Carbon Monoxide Safety

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a colourless and odourless, tasteless, yet highly toxic gas. It is called the silent killer.

Here are some steps you can take to protect yourself and your family.

#### Type of Detector

Either hard wired (with or without battery backup) or plug-in style. Must be CSA 6.19-01 approved.

#### Location

Carbon Monoxide is slightly lighter than air; therefore the detector can be placed anywhere that it can be heard.

#### Maintenance

Vacuum on occasion and replace every 5 years.

#### In Case of Alarm

Contact emergency number 873-2222. The Fire Department will test your home with highly sensitive detectors. If Carbon Monoxide is present, we will assist in locating the source.
