FIRE SAFETY AND EDUCATION

Summer Safety Tips - Barbeques

- BBQ outside only; Carbon Monoxide is a byproduct of propane (or charcoal briquettes) and can build up in unventilated areas. This includes the garage with an open door.
- Keep your BBQ away from your home, shrubs, and brush. Flare-ups have also caused the siding on homes to melt and burn.
- Check the fuel line connections for leaks by coating them with a solution of soap and water - watch for bubbles that indicate a gas leak.
- Check the propane cylinder to ensure it is not damaged or rusted.
- Ensure your propane cylinder (tank) is secured to the BBQ stand.
- When not in use, turn off the burner valves and supply valve.
