FIRE SAFETY

Stay Fire Smart - Don't Get Burnt!

Each year, roughly 180,000 people visit hospital emergency rooms with burns. Make your home fire safe and prevent painful burns. Here are a few simple safety tips:

- Keep hot foods in the centre of the table or counter
- Have a 1 metre "child-free" zone around the stove
- Teach children that hot things hurt
- Don't hold a child while preparing hot food or drinking hot beverages
- Prevent scald injuries - set the thermostat on your hot water heater no higher than 48 degrees celcius.
