The deadline to apply is Friday, October 16 at 5:00 p.m. Please note that the Proxy Voter must be eligible to vote in the Election and must vote for you at your Polling Station.

Pursuant to the *Education Act* of the NWT, residents may vote for either the Yellowknife Education District No. 1 School Board of Trustees or the Yellowknife Catholic School Board of Trustees, but not both. Be sure that your information on the Voters List is correct, you are not permitted to change your school support on Election Day.
