REMINDER TO PET OWNERS

Off Leash Areas

The City of Yellowknife would like to inform local pet owners that there is a change in the designated off leash areas located in Yellowknife. The following areas are still designated as off leash areas:

- the Sandpits, across Highway #3 from the golf course;
- Tin Can Hill, from the end of School Draw Avenue to the Con property; and
- The fenced Dog Park located behind Yellowknife Community Arena.

Due to safety concerns, Grace Lake Road is no longer considered an off leash area. The City of Yellowknife has designated ***Fiddlers Lake Road, at the end of Deh Cho Boulevard in Kam Lake as a new area*** for off leash pets.

Please remember to use a leash when using all City parks or trails. In addition, please be a responsible pet owner and pick up after your pets, including dogs and horses!
