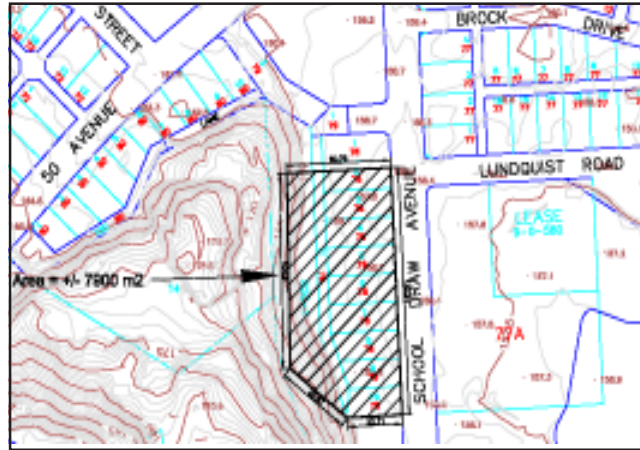

REVISED ROUTES

Yellowknife Transit

On July 25, 2005, City Council approved changes to the existing transit system to facilitate a 30 minute schedule.

The changes are as follows:

Revised Routes 1 & 3:

Routes 1 & 3 will continue in their present form with the exception of not providing service to the airport. This is due to the current bus service being chronically late and low ridership at the airport. The revised routes will enable the City to provide a consistent 30 minute schedule. In addition, the Co-op has offered to place a bus stop by its front doors, enabling residents to wait inside during colder months.

Revised Route 2:

Route 2 will continue in its present form in its entirety. However, it will now have a 40 minute service.
