Proxy Forms

The deadline to apply is Friday, October 16 at 5:00 p.m. Please note that the Proxy Voter must be eligible to vote in the Election and must vote for you at your Polling Station.

Pursuant to the *Education Act* of the NWT, residents may vote for either the Yellowknife Education District No. 1 School Board of Trustees or the Yellowknife Catholic School Board of Trustees, but not both. Be sure that your information on the Voters List is correct, you are not permitted to change your school support on Election Day. FIRE SAFETY AND EDUCATION

Propane Fire Safety

We use propane in various capacities here in the north: camping, BBQing, home heating, dryers, hot water heaters, etc. Propane is a friend but can also be a foe if not respected.

Propane is a liquid stored under pressure. When the pressure is released it turns into a heavier-than-air gas that settles in the lowest available space. It is highly flammable. If the liquid or gas escapes into our vehicles or homes, it will ignite with an ignition source (spark, flame). Take the following precautions to ensure your vehicle or home doesn't go up in flames:

- Ensure your tank is not corroded. Your BBQ tank should be replaced after 10 years;
- Store and transport your tank upright to prevent the liquid propane from escaping;
- When transporting the tank to be filled, insert the POL plug in the valve and ensure the valve is tightly closed;
- Use soapy water to test for leaks; and
- **DO NOT STORE PROPANE CYLINDERS INDOORS WHERE LEAKING GAS CAN ACCUMULATE** (indoors means any enclosed space).

Respect propane and stay fire-safe!
