

Tipping Fees

Tipping Fees (Effective January 1st, 2012)

These charges apply only to commercial establishments and residents as specified.

The following Tipping Fees shall be charged for the disposal of waste at the Solid Waste Facility.

Commercial

Construction/Demolition Waste	\$66.00 per tonne
Commercial Waste	\$90.75 per tonne
Commercial Waste from Outside City Boundaries requires prior approval	\$100.00 per tonne (\$20 minimum) + \$130/hr equipment charge with a minimum 1 hr if required
Mixed Loads	Charged at the higher rate
Light Waste Loads	\$8.00 minimum charge
Unsorted Recyclables	\$65.00 per tonne
Sorted Recyclables	\$30.00 per tonne

Construction/Demolition Waste	\$66.00 per tonne
Contaminated Soils – Hydrocarbons	\$82.50 per tonne
Contaminated Water/Snow	\$550.00 per tonne

Cooking Grease	\$30.00 per tonne
Animal Carcass - small	\$10.00 each
Animal Carcass - large	\$20.00 each
Asbestos - \$50 minimum plus \$130/hr equipment charge with a minimum 1 hr	\$150.00 per tonne
Other non-specified special waste	\$100.00 per tonne (\$50.00 minimum) +\$130/hr equipment charge, one hour minimum charge
Scrap Steel, Metal Waste	\$75.00 per tonne
Domestic Vehicles	\$150.00 each
White Goods with Freon e.g. Fridge, Freezer, air conditioners, water coolers	\$50.00 each
White Goods - other e.g. stove, dishwasher, washer, dryer, hot water tank	\$30.00 each
Good clean Scrap Wood (no fastenings/glues) not mixed with any other construction debris and/or garbage	\$66.00 per tonne
Automotive Batteries	\$6.00 per battery up to 3 batteries per month
Tires - Less than 20" in diameter	\$10.00 per tire
Tires - Greater than 20" up to 48"	\$15.00 per tire
Oil Tanks (up to 250 gallon)	\$150.00
Tree Branches	\$80.00 per tonne, minimum charge \$40
Oversized Loads - wider than 3.2 metres / 10' 6"	\$15 per cubic metre
Clean Granular Fill	No Charge

* The fees and charges for special waste shall be charged on a Cost of Service basis rather than those set out in Part 17 in instances where the level of contamination or the state of the waste is determined by the Senior Administrative Officer to be exceptional.

Residential

Mixed Waste	\$8.00 / load
White Goods with Freon e.g. Fridge, Freezer, air conditioners, water coolers	\$50.00 each
White Goods - other e.g. stove, dishwasher, washer, dryer, hot water tank	\$30.00 each
Contaminated Soils – Hydrocarbons	\$82.50 per tonne
Contaminated Water/Snow	\$550.00 per tonne
Automotive Batteries	\$6.00 per battery up to 3 batteries per month
Tires - Less than 20" in diameter	\$10.00 per tire
Tires - Greater than 20" up to 48"	\$15.00 per tire
Domestic Vehicles	\$150.00 each
Oil Tanks (up to 250 gallon)	\$150.00
Animal Carcass - small	\$10.00 each
Animal Carcass - large	\$20.00 each

Notes:

* Acceptance and determination of nature of waste is at the discretion of the Director of Public Works and Engineering or his/her designate.

*Single Family Unit Solid Waste Levy is \$14.50 per month.

Supplementary Tipping Rates:

During any period that the weigh scale is inoperable, either due to planned maintenance or repair, or if specified by the Director of Public Works and Engineering (or designate), the following Supplementary Tipping Rates will apply.
