CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE BY-LAW NO. 4585

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, to amend Fees and Charges By-law No. 4436, as amended.

PURSUANT to Sections 70, 72 and 73 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22;

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted By-law No. 4436;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is desirous of amending By-law No. 4436 as amended to reflect changes to the fees and charges collected by the City of Yellowknife as set out in the attached Parts of Schedule "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular sessions duly assembled, enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

- 1. That By-law No. 4436, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting the following Parts of Schedule "B" and replacing them with the Schedules attached hereto:
 - A. Deleting Part 9, of Schedule "B" of By-law No. 4436 as amended and replacing with Part 9 of Schedule "A" attached hereto, which shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading;
 - B. Deleting Part 12 of Schedule "B" of By-law No. 4436 as amended and replacing with Part 12 of Schedule "A" attached hereto, which shall come into effect on September 1, 2010, unless otherwise noted within the schedule;
 - C. Deleting Part 17 of Schedule "B" of By-law No. 4436 as amended and replacing with Part 17 of Schedule "A" attached hereto, which shall come into effect on January 1, 2011;
 - D. Deleting Part 19 of Schedule "B" of By-law No. 4436 as amended and replacing with Part 19 of Schedule "A" attached hereto, which shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading;

- E. Delete reference to Building By-law No. 3815 in Part 2 and replace therewith Building By-law No. 4469;
- F. Delete reference to Emergency Response and Protection Services By-law No. 3653 in Part 10 and replace therewith Emergency Response and Protection Services By-law No. 4526;
- G. Delete reference to Public Parks and Recreation By-law No. 3964 in Part 12 and replace therewith Public Parks and Recreation By-law No. 4564; and
- H. Delete reference to Zoning By-law No. 4024 in Part 18 and replace therewith Zoning By-law No. 4404.


